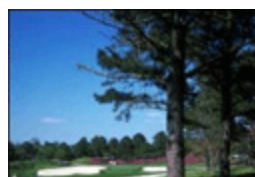

There are many sand bunkers and large trees which can alter your shots. The greens are medium speed and undulating. The Palmetto Course, is a "Bent" grass course with water in play. Built in 1972, The Palmetto course runs parallel to the Intracoastal Waterway with its signature hole #18 a very demanding par 4.
